SUNDAY REFLECTION

1st Reading: Isaiah 66.10-14c 2nd Reading: Galatians 6.14-18 Gospel: Luke 10.1-12, 17-20 Jesus Sends out the Seventy-Two

The Harvest Is Plenty

In the Gospel reading, Jesus commissions the disciples who were following him and sent them out two by two to all the places which Jesus intended to go. They were sent to prepare the way, and to prepare the hearts of the people, that they will be able to receive Jesus and his message when he comes. However, there are two stark realities that Jesus conveys to the disciples about their journey.

First, the harvest is plenty, but the labourers are few. The world is ripe for the harvest, but unfortunately the number of people willing to go out and work for the sake of building up the Kingdom of God are few. This reality was present in Jesus' time and continues to be a reality today. Jesus calls many yet only few answer the call. The second reality is that when we are sent, we are like lambs in the midst of wolves. Jesus knew that the preaching of the Gospel would come with opposition and persecution.

Jesus knows that the work will be difficult and warns his disciples of the challenges they will face. However, he also promises to be with them and extends this promise to us as well. As the Lord speaks through Isaiah in the first reading, he tells us that as a mother comforts her child, so the Lord will comfort those who are doing his will. As stewards, we are called to labour for God's kingdom, a work that can be difficult and lifelong. The harvest is plenty, but the labourers are few. Let us spend time to reflect on the ways that the Lord calls us, asking God to open our hearts to his invitation of sharing our time and talent with our parish community. Let us also pray in a special way this week for those who are labouring, and that even more people may hear the Lord's call and work in his harvest.

Summary

In today's Gospel, Jesus sends his disciples to prepare the way, saying, "the harvest is plenty, but the labourers are few." He also warns the disciples that the work of evangelization will not be easy, and that they will be like sheep among wolves, facing many challenges and obstacles along the way. The Lord calls us as he did the disciples to go and work in the harvest, and to build up the kingdom of God through the sharing of our time and talent.


