Replacement of Parish Boiler Project

Boiler Replacement is on hold as contractors cannot guarantee completion of job before end of September or October.

Earlier this year, Fr Simon and members of the Finance Council formally began the project of replacing the church's heating system. The current heating system has been in service at the church for over 56 years. Over the years the church has done minor repairs to the pumps and boiler and were becoming concerned about the expense and availability of parts to repair the system components. Further, given the boiler's age, there is no predicting when the boiler itself will fail and what it will take to repair it and return it to service when it does. That is assuming it can be repaired; more than likely the church would be facing an unplanned expense of emergency replacement during the season it is needed most. 
