The Servants of the Lord and the Virgin of Matará (www.servidoras.org or www.ssvmmissions.org), a missionary Institute of religious sisters, are happy to be given the opportunity to speak at Saint Theresa Parish for the mission appeal on July 8/9. From our beginnings in San Rafael, Argentina in 1988 we have grown to about 1600 sisters missioning in 45 different countries throughout the world. This appeal allows us to inform the members of your parish about our mission work in Egypt. As you may imagine, our missions in places like Egypt are in great need of support. Since most of the girls come from poor families, the sisters also take care of the families by giving them some assistance. As you may know, Egypt is not economically stable at present. For this reason, missionaries do not receive much help from the local people who very often themselves lack even basic necessities. Thank you, Parishioners, for this opportunity to speak at Saint Theresa and share with you about our mission in Egypt. As we daily strive to help those in need, we are most grateful to all of you for your prayers, contributions, and generosity, truly a grace from God and a consolation for our missionary sisters.
