Our next ministry night will be at St Barnabas Catholic Church (10 Washburn Way) on Wednesday, Jan 3rd, 2024 at 7pm. Please join us for 7pm mass followed by a talk from Eden O'Brien. The talk will explore why Tolkien entrusts the central mission of the Lord of the Rings novel – the guarding and destruction of the Ring - to the most seemingly incapable characters: the Hobbits. For instance, why wasn't the ring entrusted to Aragorn, the skilled warrior and King? Or to any number of the immortal and powerful Elves? Indeed, why didn't the Great Eagles simply drop the ring into Mount Doom? Tolkien's decision to call on the powers of the littlest movers of middle-earth reflects a deep understanding that the circles of the world are often turned in a hidden way and by unexpected heroes. In addition to exploring these questions, this discussion will also reflect on Tolkien's approach in relation to the Catholic Tradition. Bring your friends and see you there!
