#### POPE'S PRAYER INTENTION FOR APRIL

#### For the role of women

We pray that the dignity and immense value of women be recognized in every culture, and for the end of discrimination that they experience in different parts of the world.



The Feast of Divine Mercy offers us an opportunity to focus on the words of Jesus: "As the Father has loved me, so I have loved you: abide in my love." (John 15.9)

This observance is closely associated with St. Faustina Kowalska, a Polish nun who reported receiving visions and messages from Jesus about His mercy in the early 20th century.

Based on her visions, the image of Divine Mercy depicts Jesus with rays of red and white lights emanating from his heart symbolizing the blood and water that flowed from his side when he was pieced on the cross.

The feast of Devine Mercy reminds us that if we seek God's mercy, we cannot do this and then not be merciful ourselves. It is a day to remind us of God's boundless mercy and our call to reflect this mercy is different from forgiveness. Forgiveness requires admission of wrong doing and a penitent heart. Mercy is luxurious gift of forgiveness even if the forgiveness is unrequested and/or undeserved. We are called to receive and offer God's love. It is our call t take to heart the words of Jesus" As the Father has loved me, so I have loved you: abide in my love." (Except: Living with Christ, Michael Way Skinner)
