WORLD DAY OF PRAYER FOR THE CARE OF CREATION September 1, 2024

The World Day of Prayer for the Care of Creation on September 1, 2024, will focus on the theme **"Hope and Act with Creation"**. This day is an opportunity for people worldwide to reflect on their role as stewards of the natural world and to take action towards environmental sustainability.

Pope Francis' message for this year emphasizes the importance of living according to the Spirit and fostering a prophetic ecological imagination. He draws inspiration from Saint Paul's Letter to the Romans, highlighting the need for believers to be creative and proactive in charity, and to strive for justice and peace in harmony with creation.

In addition to the World Day of Prayer for the Care of Creation, the Season of Creation is an ecumenical initiative promoted by various groups, including the World Council of Churches, the Lutheran World Federation (LWF), the Anglican Communion and the Laudato Si' Movement. The Time of Creation lasts from September 1 to October 4, the feast of St. Francis of Assisi.
