Tap to Give

For those who prefer digital or contactless payments, **TipTap is now available for donations to the church.** We have three devices set up for **Sunday Offertory, the Shrine Wall Project or second collections, and candle payments.**

This option is not intended to replace pre-authorized giving (PAG), which involves monthly contributions from your bank account or credit card to support the parish. Instead, it offers an opportunity for parishioners and visitors who no longer carry cash or prefer digital donations to support the parish.

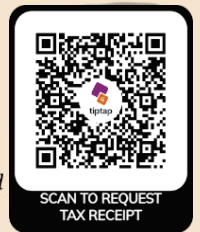

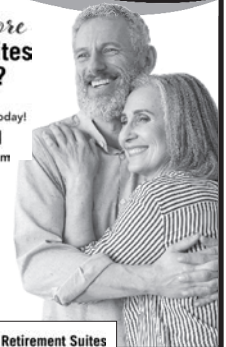
