SUNDAY CONNECTION

First Reading

Isaiah 49:3,5-6

God's servant, Israel, will be made a light to the nations.

Responsorial Psalm

Psalm 40:2,4,7-10

God desires obedience.

Second Reading

1 Corinthians 1:1-3

Paul greets the Church in Corinth.

Gospel Reading

John 1:29-34

John testifies that Jesus is the Lamb of God, God's own Son.

This Sunday, we pause from Matthew's Gospel (Cycle A) to read from John's Gospel. Unlike Matthew, John does not describe Jesus' baptism but focuses on John the Baptist's testimony that Jesus is the Son of God.

John identifies Jesus with two key titles: "**Lamb of God**" and "**Son of God**," pointing to His mission to redeem humanity. John contrasts his own baptism with water to Jesus' baptism with the Holy Spirit, emphasizing that his role was to prepare the way and make Jesus known to Israel.

This passage reminds us that, like John, we are called through our Baptism to witness to Christ by our words and actions.


