SUNDAY CONNECTION

First Reading

Isaiah 8:23-9:3

The people in darkness have seen a great light.

Responsorial Psalm

Psalm 27:1,4,13-14

The Lord is our refuge, our light, our salvation.

Second Reading

1 Corinthians 1:10-13,17

Paul urges the community at Corinth to be united as people baptized in Christ's name.

Gospel Reading

Matthew 4:12-23

Jesus begins to preach in Galilee and calls his first disciples. (shorter form Matthew 4:12-17)

In today's Gospel, Jesus begins his public ministry after his baptism and his temptation in the desert. Hearing of John the Baptist's arrest, he goes to Galilee. Matthew highlights that Jesus' ministry fulfills Isaiah's prophecy that the Messiah would bring light to Galilee, the land of the Gentiles.

Jesus calls his first disciples—Peter, Andrew, James, and John—who leave everything immediately to follow him, showing the compelling power of his presence.

The passage ends with Jesus teaching, preaching, and healing in Galilee, signs that the Kingdom of God is already breaking into the world.

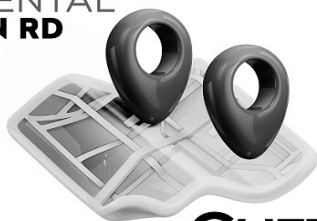
