Background on the Gospel Reading

In today's Gospel, Jesus begins the Sermon on the Mount with the Beatitudes. Although this form of teaching appears in the Old Testament, Jesus uses it to show that God's favor rests on people the world might overlook—such as the poor in spirit, the meek, and the persecuted. The Beatitudes reveal a reversal of worldly values and offer a guide for Christian living. They remind us that true happiness and blessing come not from earthly success, but from living in a way that is pleasing to God and trusting in the reward God promises.

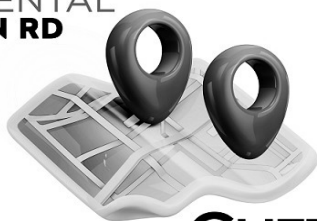
