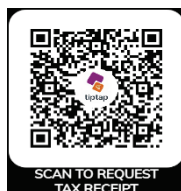

Why Parish Registration Matters for Sacramental Preparations

Registering with the parish is important for families preparing for Baptism, First Holy Communion, and Confirmation. It allows the parish to offer proper guidance, maintain accurate records, and build a strong, connected faith community. Those who are not yet registered at St. Theresa’s Parish are encouraged to contact the parish office to register. You may request for Sunday donation envelopes, as financial support is part of every Catholic’s responsibility and helps maintain the parish facilities. Families should also begin attending Sunday Mass regularly; attending any of the following fulfills the Sunday obligation: **Saturday 5 PM, Sunday 10 AM, or 12 NOON**. Registration for First Holy Communion and Confirmation begins in **September**, and Baptism application forms can be obtained by speaking with **Fr. Simon** after Sunday Mass.
