Historically known by its Latin name, **Corpus Christi**, this major feast day celebrates the real presence of Jesus Christ—Body, Blood, Soul, and Divinity—in the elements of the Eucharist.

While the institution of the Eucharist is remembered on Holy Thursday during Holy Week, this feast focuses entirely on the joy, thanksgiving, and public adoration of this great mystery.

Corpus Christi emerged in the 13th century, largely inspired by St. Juliana of Cornillon, a Belgian nun who had a recurring vision of a full moon with a dark spot, symbolizing the Church lacking a feast dedicated solely to the Blessed Sacrament.

Following a Eucharistic miracle in Bolsena, Italy, Pope Urban IV instituted the solemnity for the entire Church in 1264. He commissioned the great theologian St. Thomas Aquinas to compose the prayers and hymns for the feast, which include the beloved Pange Lingua and Tantum Ergo.

June: The Month of the Sacred Heart of Jesus

Following the beautiful feasts of Pentecost and Corpus Christi, the Church dedicates the entire month of June to the **Sacred Heart of Jesus**. This devotion is a profound reminder of God's burning, unconditional love for humanity and His deep desire for a relationship with each of us.

New Papal Encyclical: *Magnifica Humanitas* (Magnificent Humanity)

Safeguarding the human person and protecting human dignity in the era of Artificial Intelligence (AI) and rapid technological change.

Pope Leo XIV has issued the first encyclical of his pontificate, timed intentionally to mark the 135th anniversary of Pope Leo XIII's landmark social encyclical, *Rerum Novarum* (which addressed workers' rights during the Industrial Revolution). Pope Leo XIV positions the current AI boom as a modern digital revolution that carries immense potential but poses deep moral and social challenges.

Reflection Questions for Our Daily Lives:

As we integrate technology into our homes and workplaces, the Holy Father invites us to ask:

1. Does this technology help me remain faithful to objective truth?
2. Does it protect families and young people from digital dependency?
3. Does it help me cultivate genuine closeness in relationships where physical presence is crucial?
