## Upcoming Mission Appeal

Fr. Manuel R. Guico will be conducting Mission Appeals on the weekend of August 15-16, 2026, at Saint Theresa's Parish, seeking financial partnership and generosity from the community.

Helping the Missionary Cooperation Plan (MCP) for the Diocese of San Jose is vital because it directly impacts lives where resources are scarce. Supporting this mission matters for several key reasons:

- **Serving the Most Vulnerable:** The diocese acts as a safety net for those society often overlooks. Your support directly funds homes for abandoned elderly citizens (*TDK*) and neglected orphans (*Tahanan ng Awa*), giving them safety, dignity, and care.
- **Empowering Marginalized Communities:** Indigenous and tribal groups in these remote mountainous areas are isolated and cut off from growth. The Church provides outreach that bridges the gap, offering paths to formal education and sustainable livelihoods.
- **Providing Essential Healthcare:** In poor and depressed farming villages, basic medical care is a luxury. The Community-Based Health Program (CBHP) delivers life-saving medicines and crucial nutritional support directly to families in need.
- **Overcoming Limited Local Resources:** While the diocese is rich in spirit, its local population consists primarily of hardworking, low-income farmers. They face economic hardships and cannot financially sustain these extensive social programs alone.
- **Living the Call to Stewardship:** True faith is about transforming communal intentions into concrete actions of love. By partnering with missionaries like Fr. Manuel R. Guico, you extend your reach globally, directly fulfilling the universal Church's mandate to serve "the least of our brothers and sisters."
